

Financial Assistance Request – Membership Fees

Requirements for Financial Assistance requests:

- Applicant is a new member of the Girl Scout Council of the Florida Panhandle, Inc.
- Adults applying must be registering as a leader, co-leader, Scouter-Outer or First-Aider for a troop.
- Applicant is unable to participate without financial assistance

Procedures for requesting Financial Assistance:

- Complete one application per person per request.
- Complete all portions of the Financial Assistance application. Incomplete information will delay your request.
- Submit the Financial Assistance application and the **Membership Registration form** to your troop leader. Forms must be submitted at the same time to the Council
